Screening Checklist

Wash hands
Wear protective gear including: Gloves, face mask, goggles, scrub top
At the first drop off, parents must sing (using their own pen or a sanitized pen):
Self-Attestation form declaring they are an essential employee
☐ LS Parent Agreement to updated policies
Ask a series of health screening questions:
Have any of the following symptoms been noticed at home?
☐ Fever
□ Rash
☐ Vomiting
☐ Diarrhea
☐ Cough
Loss of smell or taste
□ Record on Screening Spreadsheet
☐ If any of the above symptoms are mentioned, the child will need to stay home
Take the child's temperature using a non-contact thermometer.
□ Record on Screening Spreadsheet
Any child whose temperature is higher than 100 will need to stay home
Sanitize the thermometer after each use
Parent removes child from car
Upon entering the building, staff will take the child into an empty classroom or bathroom
to wash hands, faces and arms prior to entering the classroom.
Give the child to the teacher but try not to enter the classroom. Tell the teacher the time
they "entered our care" by using the temperature time.
Place all supplies in the designated area outside the classroom until further notice.
Lunch boxes can be placed outside until the teacher needs them.
Washes hands, cleans the thermometer and puts on new gloves prior to getting the nex
child.
After parent drop off, staff member removes and cleans all protective gear, including
scrubs and mask wash in laundry
Sanitize sink used for handwashing and doorknob and key pad (if used)
