

Color Conversations

As you get your child dressed, tell him/her the colors of the clothes you are putting on him/her: "Blue pants, white diaper, and yellow shirt." Hold them up to let your child look and feel them as you describe each one. When your child responds to what you are doing, respond back.



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When you describe colors to your child, your words offer opportunities for him/her to make connections between words and their meanings. This will help your child learn to talk, read and communicate.
