

**Coronavirus Relief and Recovery Supplemental Assistance Act (CRRSA) Provider Funding Snapshot**

NH DHHS was awarded \$19.9 million in overall funding through the Administration for Children & Families - Office of Child Care

75% of \$19.9 million = \$14,925,000 is being directly awarded to child care providers across the state

\* Family Child Care providers with a single provider and one-part time helper automatically received a base classroom rate of \$3,000 regardless of the number of children. Licensed Family Group homes with multiple classrooms and multiple staff were funded by classroom and staffing numbers after confirmation.

As of March 31, 2021, NH DHHS has funded 571 total programs/providers, representing \$14,231,471 awards of the \$14,925,000 allocated for direct provider support. While we still have some adjustments to make, this is an exciting accomplishment and represents immediate support to over 30,000 children, 6,600+ staff in all counties in New Hampshire.
